Two years ago we held our Annual Dinner at Brandeston Hall and the Dinner was preceded by an afternoon of activities. To judge from comments received afterwards, this format was a successful one, and we intend to repeat it this year at The College. Such a format makes it more worthwhile to travel some distance and to make a weekend, or at least a day of it. Even more attractive is the fact that the College can offer reasonably priced, comfortable accommodation in Pembroke House.

The activities will be comparable to, but different from, those arranged at Brandeston. If you have not recently been back to the College it will be possible to see how things have changed, and also to see plans for the future.

Events/Activities: (organised by Norman Porter, returns to him please)

1 Buffet lunch (12.00–1.30pm) at the Crown in Framlingham for approximately £10 per head. This has to be confirmed and paid for in advance, to ensure provision for correct numbers.

2 Planned walk around the area (depart 2.00pm) – easy or strenuous options. Once again, Vice President Bob Williams, who knows the terrain from his years of organising cross-country runs, will be charting the trail.

3 6-a-side hockey Tournament (2.00pm onwards) Male and female teams invited. Do try to get together a team of friends, year group etc. All generations welcome. The format will depend on the entries received. Astroturf pitches booked 2.00–5.00 pm.

4 Golf (tee off 1.30–2.00) Neil Jackson (married to OF, Kate) of Cretingham Golf Club, has offered discounted golf in the early afternoon: £10 for 9 holes or £15 for 18 holes. The College Golf Course will also be available for use.

6 Squash (pm) – Douglas Thomson has offered to organise this, but contact Norman Porter in the first instance.

Changing facilities for males and females, including the deluxe shower room, will be available between 4.00–6.00pm in the white pavilion next to the wooden pavilion on the Back. Please see attached time sheet for all the day's plans.

Refreshments from 5.00pm–6.00pm. Teas, coffees and biscuits will be served in Paul's Court. Please confirm by **Wednesday 21st March.**

Viewing of College and development plans. The main school buildings will be open and development plans will be on display.

Accommodation in Pembroke House.

The number of rooms is limited and will be available on a first come, first served basis. As the College breaks up this Saturday 24th March, rooms will not be available until 4.00pm.

The cost, inclusive of breakfast is: Single Room £27.50 per person, and £37.50 for a twin (to be paid in advance). Accommodation details are required by **Friday 16th March** and no later. Rooms are not en suite and guests will have to use the shared facilities. Breakfast will be served on Sunday 25th March between 8.30am–9.30am.
