We regret to announce that Jim Crosbie died yesterday after a long illness.

Jim joined the Wimbledon Hockey Club in the late 1980s from Tulse Hill H.C. and became a key member of the Veterans Sparrows X1.

He was a dominant and skilful centre half and played on many occasions against WHC for the Puritans Hockey Club of which he was a member for over 20 years.

Jim played hockey for Scotland 49 times in the 1970s and was also captain of the Kent hockey team.

On his retirement from hockey in 1995 Jim joined the Lakeside Squash Club and ran the leagues for many years.

He also served as a member of the squash committee as treasurer and became a qualified squash umpire.

Jim rarely missed supporting the Club's golf society organised by fellow squash player Martin Sumpton and when Martin stood down Jim took over.

Jim was passionate about the Club and was always ready to help when required.
