The names on the bottle are:

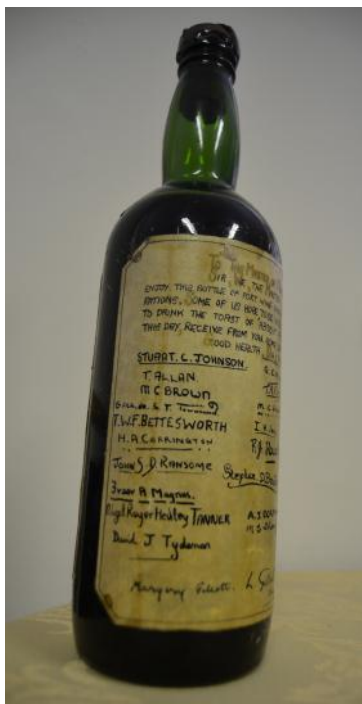
