

KEITH ROGER ATTER (G57-65)

He was born on 23 February 1946 and lived in Purley Surrey.

On leaving the College he obtained a BA before joined the Royal Navy and becoming an acting Sub-Lieutenant attending Britannia Royal Naval College. On Wednesday 14 August 1968 he tragically died off the coast of Germany, when he fell overboard from the training sailing vessel Leopard (pictured). He was missing presumed drowned.

There is a small plaque in the College Chapel, put there by his parents, saying that the altar rails were put in place in his memory - these are the rails which divide the blue seats from the part where we walk in once coming through the main door and are fittingly below the plaque.

He is buried in Hanover Military Cemetery and I am grateful to the War Graves Photographic Project for providing the following images.
