School Information	Eldest son of WT Brunger, who was bursar at the College. Brother of William Valentine Brunger (1904-07). Senior prefect. Chair of Debating Society. Football XI 1910-11. Sergeant OTC.
Career Information	Dairy farmer in New Zealand.

Cause of Death	Killed in action
Location	Bellicourt, Somme
Cemetery	British Cemetery at Bellicourt, Somme, France Grave : VII D 8 Beneath the War Memorial in the Chapel is a marble table on which stands a brass cross and a pair of vases for flowers. These were dedicated on the anniversary of Armistice Day in 1923, in memory of him.
Rank	Captain
Branch of Service	New Zealand Expeditionary Force and Norfolk Regiment. He was appointed Captain and won his DSO on 24 June 1916. The citation reads "for conspicuous gallantry when leading a successful raid on the enemy's trenches". He was also mentioned in dispatches and wounded.
