

## Suffolk Supper 2014

The Suffolk Supper will take place at the College on Saturday 18 October 2014. As last year this will be in a buffet format. The last three years' Suffolk Suppers have marked a departure from traditional sit-down suppers. The buffet format has been hailed as a considerable success, so we are repeating that format again this year. Tables will be properly set up, so there will be no need to walk around, performing a difficult balancing act with food, cutlery and glass, while eating and talking at the same time. Places will not be specifically set, so you are free to move around, and to mix and mingle, rather than be fixed at one particular table.

There will be wine already on the tables and a cash bar will also be open in the annex to the Dining Room from about 7.00. The buffet self-service supper will be available from then over the following two hours. If there are any special dietary requirements please let me know.

Even though the supper is free, booking for the supper is **essential** as we need to know numbers. Priority has been given to donors until 19 September, so non-donors will now be accepted on a first come first served basis. Numbers are limited. Lists will be closed on October 11<sup>th</sup>.
