IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT OF THE SOF - PLEASE READ, COMPLETE AND RETURN ASAP.

Framlingham College is planning to switch publication of **The Framlinghamian** from a **printed magazine** to an **on-line version**.

This change is not absolute, as a printed copy will be available to those who request it, as before. However, in the interests of reducing costs, it is hoped that many OFs will opt for the on-line version from 2020.

Some decisions have already been made:

 post-1980s Old Framlinghamians living overseas will not receive a printed copy of The Framlinghamian unless they specifically request one.

Earlier this year, UK-based OFs on the SOF database were emailed asking them to opt-in or opt-out from receiving a printed copy of The Framlinghamian. The return from this trawl was poor. Also, it did not capture the decision of those whose email addresses are not listed on the OF database.

Consequently, I decided to write to all UK-based OFs (excepting those who chose not to receive a printed copy in the earlier survey), to request a decision on whether you wish to receive a printed copy of The Framlinghamian in future years.

To allow individuals to make an informed choice, an on-line version of The Framlinghamian, produced with improved software, may be accessed at www.oldframlinghamian.com Because each individual's default setting will remain a printed copy, it's vital that you make clear your preference for an on-line version if the anticipated savings are to be realised.
